PROHIBITED SUBSTANCE RULE

1. A pony will be presented for a race free of prohibited substance.
2. No person shall during any day of racing or trialling, in respect of the pony entered in a race, administer any substance whatsoever.
3. All ponies entered in an event are subject to being swabbed at the discretion of the Committee.
4. Any person who commits a breach of either of these rules will be disqualified immediately and will need to return any prizes received.
5. NSW Mini Trot Association reserve the right to impose any other penalty they see fit.

ALCOHOL AND DRUG TESTING

Mini Trotting Associations are committed to providing a safe environment for every person involved in events and associated activities.

Alcohol and Drugs of abuse in ponies, and or people, risk the welfare of themselves, the ponies, and fellow participants.

There is no place for alcohol or drugs of abuse of any kind in or around mini trotting. Any such activity or behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in sanctions which may include suspension or disqualification from competing in mini trot competitions or warning off from licensed racetracks.

Ponies

Mini Trotting ponies and their connections, including licensees, parents, owners, and veterinarians are bound by Australian Harness Racing Rules (AHRR) and subject to AHRR 188, 188A, 189 – 194, 195, 195A, 196, 196A, and 196B.

People

Mini Trotting participants, including licensees, parents, owners, volunteers, and administrators are bound by Australian Harness Racing Rules (AHRR) and subject to AHRR 250, 251, 252, and 252A-F.

- ✚ Nomination Fees \$100 per driver for one horse.
- ✚ Each horse nominated by same driver \$30 for each horse.
- ✚ If 2 or more drivers drive the same horse an additional \$30 to be paid for each driver if the driver is not nominated on any other horse.
- ✚ No nominations will be accepted after closing date.
- ✚ Horses must be Micro Chipped for identification purpose.
- ✚ All NSW Drivers and horses must be registered and qualified with NSWMTA.
- ✚ All horses being nominated for the Championship MUST be measured no later than 7pm on the 29TH of March 2024.
- ✚ Camping and stabling free rates Friday 29th – Sunday 31st March 2024 for participants, immediate family, or guardian only. Outside this date to book with Paceway Tamworth.
- ✚ All Drivers and horses MUST have competed at 3 different days at a registered harness meeting prior to close of nominations to be eligible for the Annual Championship.
- ✚ Horse nomination form & payment must go directly to your club secretary.
- ✚ Make cheque payments payable to NSW MINI TROTTING ASSOCIATION INC.

Horses will be measured in centimetres with 4 Divisions -

Midgets - 81cm-93cm (500 Front)

Shetlands - 94cm-106cm (600 Front)

Mini Ponies - 107cm-119cm (700 Front)

Ponies - 120cm-132cm (800 Front)

5cm handicap each CM in height.

CAMPING INFORMATION

Please read the following Housekeeping Camp Rules for a safe 2024 NSW Mini Trotting Championships. Office 0267659382 or mobile 0428337170 Office open 9am – 5pm

Camp Areas:

Horse are not permitted within camp areas.

Communal Picnic Area:

This area is not for camping under. No vehicles or horses permitted.

Vest and Helmet:

All children must wear their vest and helmet when working horses.

Personal Belongings:

Paceway Tamworth & HRNSW shall not be liable for any loss or damage to your property by theft or personal injury. All personal belongings must be kept within your campsite. Do not obstruct paths or roadways. Vehicles must be parked clear of roadways.

Supervision:

Children are to be always supervised. Underage drinking will not be tolerated.

Amenities:

There are 3 amenities blocks available within the camping grounds. Each has showers and toilets. All visitors are asked to keep the toilets and showers as clean and tidy as possible. Please use the bins provided in the amenities block. Please turn taps off and do not place articles likely to cause obstructions into the basins, sinks or toilets. Children under the age of 10 are to be supervised when using the facilities.

Speed Limit:

Please always observe a maximum 10kph speed limit on all roads within Paceway Tamworth. NSW Road rules apply within these grounds. Unlicensed drivers will be dealt with by NSW Police Force.

Dogs:

Dogs are permitted in Paceway Tamworth grounds provided they are always kept on a lead and under control. Dogs must be kept away from horse activities including the Harness Racing Track. Dogs are strictly prohibited in the amenities block. Please ensure that dog droppings are disposed of using the waste bins provided.

Fires:

The lighting of fires is strictly prohibited. Anyone lighting fires will be removed from the grounds.

Rubbish:

All rubbish is to be placed in one of the many appropriately marked rubbish bins provided around the grounds of Paceway Tamworth. Yellow Recycle bins are also distributed throughout the campgrounds. Don't waste Tamworth – Recycle.

Smoking:

Smoking is NOT permitted in any building including the stable areas on the grounds of Paceway Tamworth. Designated Smoking Area signs are placed around the grounds.

Electricity:

No piggy backing of power to sites. 15amp power outlets have been provided. All caravans, campers and trailers must be wired to AS/NS 3001. Any problems with power, contact the office or call the Manager on 0428 337 170.

WWC Checks

Persons over 18 attending NSW Mini Trot Championships must have a current working with children's check to attend NSW Mini Trot Championships. HRNSW will be provided with a copy of participants working with children's check details.

FEES Camping and stabling free rates Friday 29th March – Sunday 31st March 2024 for participants, immediate family or guardian only. Outside this to book with Paceway Tamworth.
