Harness Racing NSW and NSW Mini Trotting Association would like to welcome you to Paceway Tamworth for the 35th Annual NSW Mini Trotting Championships.

To ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable time here this week there are a few rules for everyone to adhere to.

- 1: **Everyone must recognise and abide by the NSW Mini Trotting Association Code of Conduct.**
- 2: We understand that everyone would like a campfire to sit around at night, we did apply for a permit. Unfortunately due to the ongoing dry conditions and the extension of the fire danger period our application was declined. Therefore acting on the advice from Fire & Rescue NSW "no fires to be lit in accordance with the legislation pertaining to the fire danger period." No valid permits means no fires lit.

Any contravention of the Fire Brigades Act 1989 carries a maximum penalty of \$8000.

Cooking may be performed on electric or gas BBQs provided that the BBQ is lit, maintained and used for the purpose of cooking a meal and is maintained by a competent person.
- 3: NSW Mini Trotting events are Alcohol and Smoke free events. Alcohol will only be permitted within the camp areas at the conclusion of each days racing. Smoking areas have been placed around the grounds for you to use. Smoking is not permitted within **any** building on the grounds of Paceway Tamworth, this includes all stable areas and any areas for use by spectators.
- 4: Horses are not permitted within the camping areas. The cattle lawn area is available for you to graze horses. The arena area is available for the kids to ride their ponies. All kids must wear helmets and safety vests whilst riding and parents must supervise their children at all times.
- 5: Please respect our senior trainers and allow them safe passage to and from the track each morning. Senior Trainers have the track Mon- Fri 5am-12pm and 3pm-7pm. Track maintenance will be carried out between 12pm and 1pm. Mini trotting track work has been allocated Mon- Fri between 1pm and 3pm. Please do not enter the track area if senior horses or machinery is on the track.
- 6: Harness Racing NSW and NSW Mini Trotting Association will not be responsible for any personal items, equipment or horses. Your possessions are your responsibility. Any surveillance devices **MUST** be approved by Paceway Tamworth management prior to installation.
- 7: Whilst our staff and the NSW Mini Trotting Association have worked hard to set the grounds up for your event, we ask that you keep your areas clean and tidy at all times.
